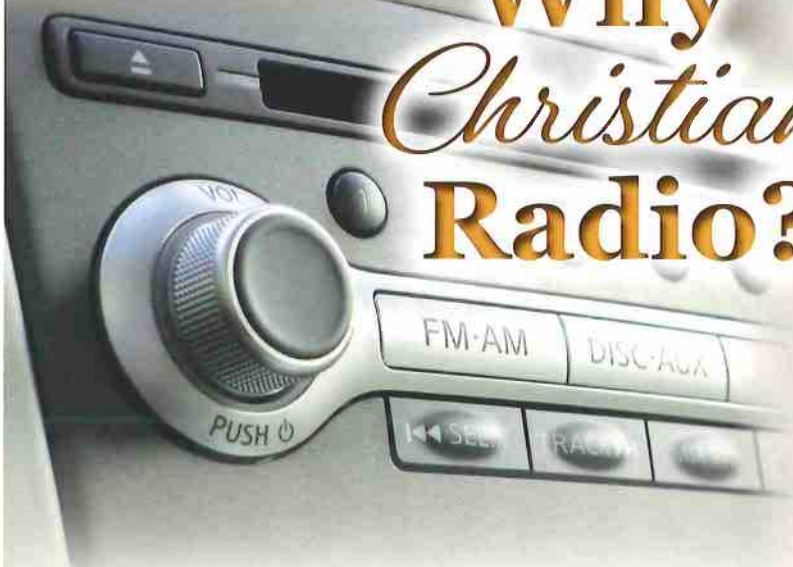

Another good reason to listen to Christian radio is that **the Lord may want you to serve Him in that ministry.** I volunteered at a local Christian radio station and became acquainted with BBN. In time, it became clear to me that serving Him through the ministry of BBN was God's plan for my life. My roles have varied from being a volunteer, a part-time announcer, a station manager, and currently the resource manager at our headquarters. These roles represent 35+ years of ministry with BBN.

A final reason Christian radio is important became clear to me as I visited our listeners. **BBN is a vital part of their daily routine.** Whether they were elderly and shut in at home, or a young family always on the go, they listened all the time. They really missed the station when it went off the air and prayed for us during those times. This made me realize that there are people listening who really depend on the ministry of BBN to be there for them.

The outbreak of COVID-19 affected the way we conduct our Share-a-thons. Last year, for the first time in more than twenty years, I was able to answer faith promise calls. What a blessing it was. Many of the callers reminded me of the listeners I visited many years ago. They still rely on BBN radio to be their constant companion. During those calls there was laughter and tears as the callers shared how much the ministry of BBN meant to them. **"Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep"** (Romans 12:15). I had the opportunity to do both.

Lowell Davey, BBN's founder, often said, **"Thank you for caring, thank you for sharing and thank you for praying for BBN."** We wish to echo that thought as BBN continues to share the good news of salvation through Jesus Christ for years to come.

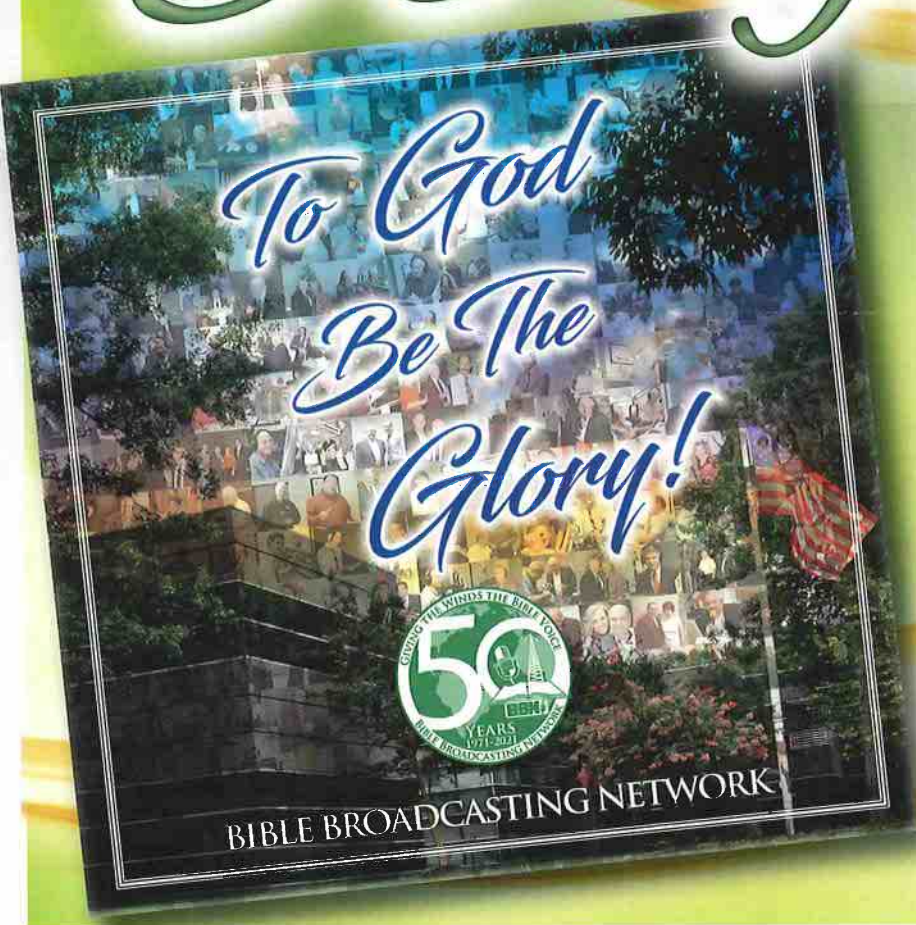

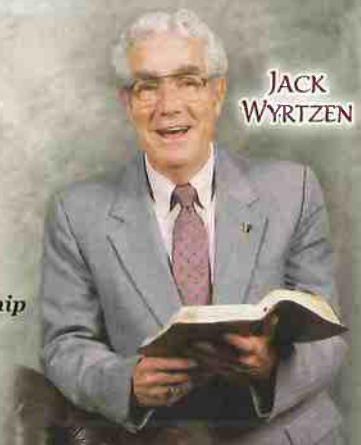
